Today, companies are losing revenue to a handful of search engines and ad networks. Google, Yahoo and DoubleClick control over 90% of the Western World's interactive advertising. Referencing Thomas Paine's Common Sense, a 1776 pamphlet about America's colonial struggle with England, Clarence Briggs, CEO of tyBit, argues that it is ridiculous and unfair that an oligarchy of websites dominate the Internet.

Briggs has examined the grudging cooperation between this oligarchy and other companies, proposing strategies for success. tyBit knows that the current model of online advertising and revenue sharing is broken. We believe it lacks transparency and is rife with unfairness and fraud. tyBit reaches out to companies in order to establish a type of Bill of Rights to govern this interrelationship. tyBit has developed seven practical strategies that companies can pursue when negotiating with the interactive giants, including demands for transparency, accountability and fairness. tyBit advocates a strategy of independence, alternatives, and self-reliance as well as a mechanism for cooperation. We believe that everyone has a choice. Paraphrasing Thomas Paine, "A long habit of not thinking a thing wrong, gives it a superficial appearance of being right, and raises at first a formidable outcry in defense of custom."

tyBit offers the simple facts, plain arguments, and common sense.

Sean A. McCoy, CMO

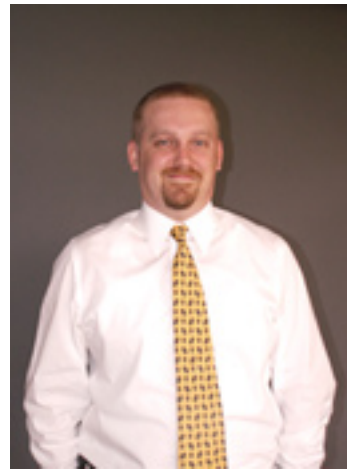
